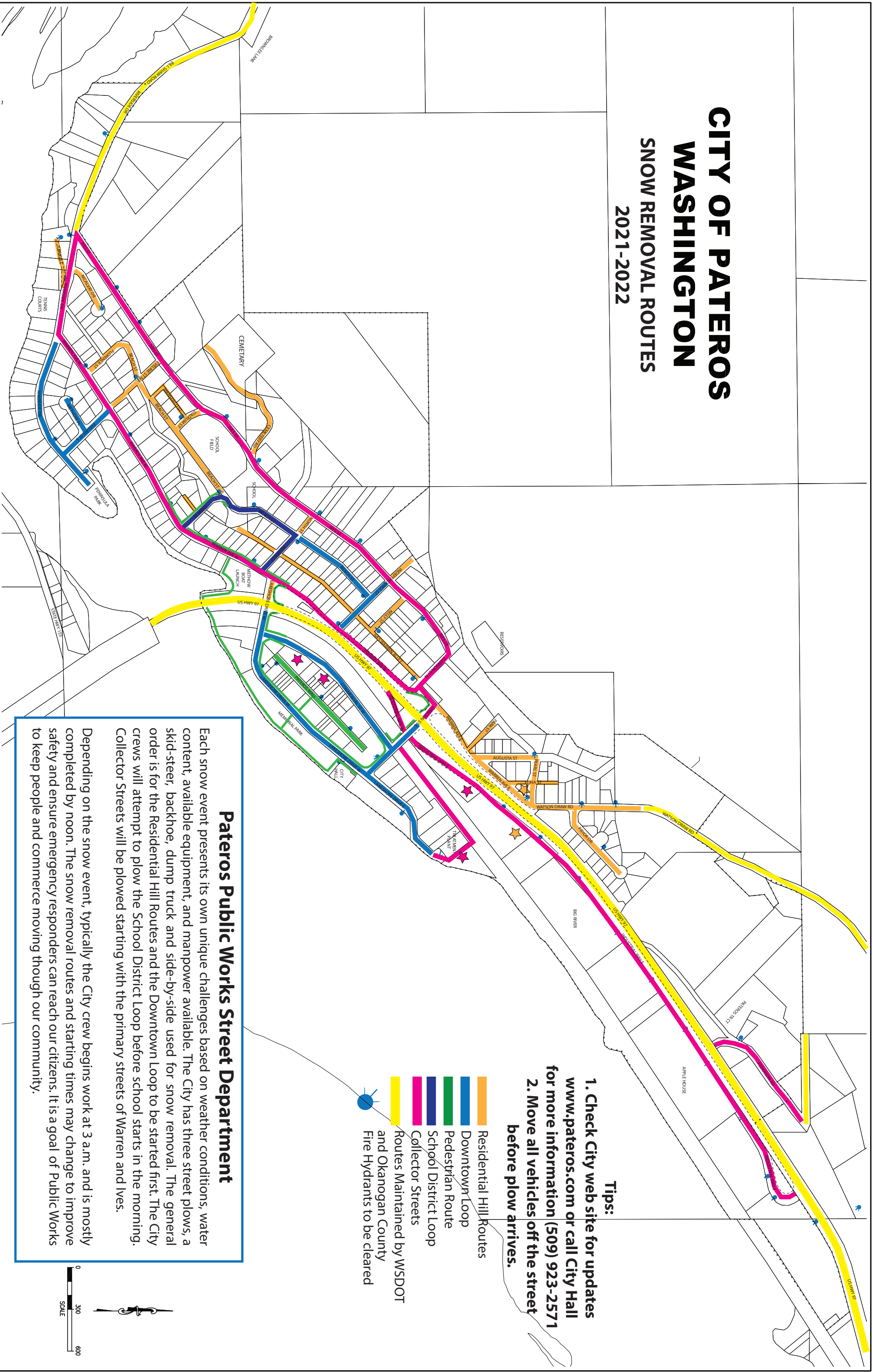


# CITY OF PATEROS WASHINGTON SNOW REMOVAL ROUTES 2021-2022

**Pateros Public Works Street Department**

Each snow event presents its own unique challenges based on weather conditions, water content, available equipment, and manpower available. The City has three street plows, a skid-steer, backhoe, dump truck and side-by-side used for snow removal. The general order is for the Residential Hill Routes and the Downtown Loop to be started first. The City crews will attempt to plow the School District Loop before school starts in the morning. Collector Streets will be plowed starting with the primary streets of Warren and Ives.

Depending on the snow event, typically the City crew begins work at 3 a.m. and is mostly completed by noon. The snow removal routes and starting times may change to improve safety and ensure emergency responders can reach our citizens. It is a goal of Public Works to keep people and commerce moving through our community.
